


No Uniform Day (N.U.D.)

Students will come to school on no uniform days dressed in neat, modest and appropriate attire. Clothing must be in good condition and reflect Catholic values with respect to physical fit and modesty.

1 Shirts, Sweatshirts and Sweaters

- Shirts may be short or long-sleeved
- Shirts may not be halter tops, tight-fitting or show
- stomach or lower-back
- A shirt must be worn over/under all tank tops and spaghetti strap tops

2 Pants

- Loose fitting joggers may be worn
- Pajama bottoms may not be worn unless allowed for a dress up event
- Low riders may not be worn
- Leggings and yoga pants may not be worn as pants

3 Shorts

- Must be uniform shorts, MS gym shorts or Spiritwear
 About (Newton) OLC)
- shorts (that say OLG)

Skirts and Dresses

- Skirts and dresses may be worn Not to be shorter than 2 inches above the top of the knee cap
- Dresses may not be halter tops, tight-fitting or show stomach or lower-back
- A shirt must be worn over/under all tank tops and spaghetti strap dresses

5 Modesty Shorts and Leggings

- Modesty shorts/leggings are required with skirts and dresses
- Shorts should not extend below hem of skirt or dress

6 Shoes

• No boots, platform/high heels, sandals, backless shoes, crocs, wheeled or light-up shoes

Additional Notes

- No hair extensions/unsual dyes or fashion head scarves
- No hats/ball caps unless allowed for a dress up event
- No face/body paint or glitter
- No make-up for Kindergarten 5th Grade
- No body piercing other than ears
- No ripped or torn clothing
- No clothing that displays weapons, alcohol, tobacco, drugs or inappropriate language, pictures or messages
- Students may not display undergarments
